Mónica Bizzarri






THE PROCESS

Each piece of art is created with individual handmade ceramic pieces, without a mold. Hundreds and thousands of them. First they are fired, then rusted (painted), then fired again at very high temperatures. Finally, they are strung and sewn together. Each piece evoques a loom. Not a picture, sculpture, carpet or rug.

























Mud tells us about our origins and our history. Through this organic and primal element we learn about our past civilizations. We have tried to understand this gift of the earth, the magic of it's chemistry and its infinite possibilities.

We have taken this element and given it a new voice, our voice. We strive to break paradigms and work with the clay as if it is a new matter. We seek to transform the rigid into flexible. We seduce the mud by bending, stretching and sewing with it.

It is clear in our work repetition dominates. Different ways of looking at the same topic, sensitively getting to know each little piece's secret, and repeating it with a different tone.

Retake, reuse, repeat...we offer a contrasting point of view, a different start and repetition that intensifies the meaning of each piece.

From a place of adventured experimentation reflection occurs and ideas born. Work, yes, but filled with playfulness.
